Interior Surfaces/ Sanitation	Interior Surfaces, walls, cages, counters, tables, runs, food and water containers need to be constructed and maintained so that they are water resistant and can be cleaned and sanitized. Waste Disposal	Animal hair, waste, and refuse shall be removed every 24 hours and stored in a fly tight container until removed from facility. Ventilation	Areas for pet animals shall be ventilated with fresh or filtered air to minimize odors and moisture.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>

Enclosures/Spacing	Adequate space shall be provided in holding and drying areas. This space is deemed as large enough to allow the animal to stand, lie down, and turn around.
