

RESOLUTION NUMBER 20-7802

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE 2020 CENSUS – COMPLETE COUNT COMMITTEE ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, April 1, 2020 will mark the 230th year since the first U.S. Census taken in 1790 and Article I, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution mandates that a nationwide census be conducted every 10 years for the purpose of apportioning representation among the states in the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 U.S. Census will describe the Nation and the communities that local governments serve by determining how many people live in each community, where they live, how they are housed and their social needs; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2019 The Salina City Commission passed Resolution 19-7786 creating a local Complete Count Committee to promote the awareness of the 2020 Census, and

WHEREAS, A Complete Count Committee is a volunteer committee established by the local governing body (City Commission) that typically includes a cross section of community leaders, including representatives from governmental agencies, education, business, religious organizations, community agencies, minority organizations and the media, and

WHEREAS, The Complete Count Committee is charged with developing and implementing an Action Plan that addresses promotion, awareness, recruiting, and enumeration assistance designed to target and address the needs of the community; SO NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Salina, Kansas:

Section 1. The document titled, 2020 Census – Complete Count Committee Action Plan, as presented February 3, 2019 at a regularly scheduled meeting of the City Commission is accepted by the Governing Body.

Section 2. City staff is authorized and directed to support the Complete Count Committee with all available resources necessary to implement the 2020 Census – Complete Count Committee Action Plan.

Section 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
