- ◇ When Salina has been struck by disasters in the past, many people were put at risk because of the inability to communicate effectively with those who are not English-proficient.
- ◇ Duties could include things such as helping to make recordings for Saline County Emergency Management's information systems, going door-to-door to provide emergency information, etc.
- ◇ To volunteer in a disaster situation, Saline County Emergency Management's policy is that people must be registered ahead of time as a volunteer at Volunteer Connection, 239 N. Santa Fe. Training is available through the Red Cross.
- ◇ The greatest need is for Spanish-speaking volunteers, but speakers of other languages (particularly Vietnamese) also are being sought so that we can serve every people group.
