

Attend BAB & Get Continuing Education Credit

Recognizing the importance that participation in the code development process plays in education, continuing education hours will be awarded for attendance at the monthly Building Advisory Board meetings. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of the month, 4:00 p.m., in Room 107 of the City County Building.

Specific agenda information can be found on the City's website and is posted on the Friday preceding each monthly meeting. You may also subscribe to the mailing list, from the city's website, and you will receive the Building Advisory Board agenda packet notice via email. That email will serve as a reminder and also will inform you as to the content of the upcoming meeting.

The following guidelines are used to calculate credits:

- Hours will be granted on a 1 to 2 ratio, meaning that 30 minutes of education will be granted for every full hour of attendance.
- If a meeting is cancelled due to lack of a quorum, inclement weather or other valid reason there will be no credit given for continuing education.
- If a meeting is held but does not last at least one hour a minimum of 30 minutes continuing education credit will still be given.
- Those wishing to have their attendance credited for continuing education must sign in and out, and must pick up a certificate before they leave the meeting room.
- For those individuals licensed in other jurisdictions, Building Services makes no assurances that these hours will be approved in other communities for license renewal.
- Board members will receive credit at a 1 to 1 ratio.
