SUBJECT: Downtown Streetscape Improvements Project

Staff and design consultant (HDR) will be providing an update on the Downtown Streetscape Improvements project to discuss the recommended final design for Santa Fe Avenue (Mulberry to Elm), adjacent plazas and streetscape areas outside the Santa Fe Avenue limits.

Items that will be discussed include:

- Recommended Streetscape elements (Furnishings, Brick Colors, Brick Patterns, Materials, etc.)
- Entrance Gateways, Corner Monuments and Sculpture Pedestals
- Recommended Overhead Structure Design – Metal Panels, Lighting
- Updated rendering of Intersection Node
- Recommended Plaza Designs for Spilman, Strand, Campbell, and Phillips Plazas
- Improvements to Mulberry Street, Walnut Street, Iron Avenue and Ash Street
- 4th Street Improvements being Deferred until Car Museum is better defined
- Estimated Construction Cost
 - Base Project
 - Bid Alternates
 - Campbell, Spilman, Strand and Phillips Plazas
 - Mulberry Streetscape Improvements (4th Street to 2nd Street)
 - Walnut & Iron – Mid-Block Crossing Upgrades
- Santa Fe Drive water main replacement items – slides to be presented by Martha Tasker
