

Update – Household Batteries

The Household Hazardous Waste Facility **is no longer accepting alkaline batteries for recycling.** Alkaline batteries are considered non-hazardous and may be disposed of in your household trash.



We continue to accept and recycle the following household battery types:

- **Lithium**
- **Rechargeable** – Ni-Cad, NiMh, Lithium-Ion
- **Button Cell** – Hearing aid, Watch, etc.
