for new construction and alterations

The Americans with Disabilites Act (ADA) requires that all new public accommodations and commercial facilities, including small businesses, must be accessible to and usable by people with disabilities.

28 CFR 36.401 (a) (1)

SECTION 35.151 of 28 CFR PART35 § 35.151 NEW CONSTRUCTION & ALTERATIONS

IN CHOOSING WHICH ACCESSIBLE
ELEMENTS TO PROVIDE, PRIORITY
SHOULD BE GIVEN TO THOSE ELEMENTS
THAT WILL PROVIDE THE GREATEST
ACCESS, IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER—
(1) AN ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCE:

- (1) AN ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCE;
- (2) AN ACCESSIBLE ROUTE TO THE ALTERED AREA;
- (3) AT LEAST ONE ACCESSIBLE RESTROOM FOR EACH SEX OR A SINGLE UNISEX RESTROOM;
 - (4) ACCESSIBLE TELEPHONES;
 - (5) ACCESSIBLE DRINKING FOUNTAINS; AND
- (6) WHEN POSSIBLE, ADDITIONAL ACCESSIBLE ELEMENTS SUCH AS PARKING, STORAGE, AND ALARMS.

20% RULE

"When the cost of alterations necessary to make the project fully accessible is disproportionate to the cost of the overall alteration, consult your design professional to see how the 20% rule applies to your project." 28 CFR 36.403 (g) (1)







KEY TERMS

DISPROPORTIONATE: WHEN COST OF ALTERATIONS MADE TO PROVIDE AN ACCESSIBLE PATH OF TRAVEL EXCEEDS 20% OF THE COST OF THE ALTERATION TO THE PRIMARY FUNCTION AREA. 28 CFR 36.403(F) (1)

PATH OF TRAVEL: A CONTINUOUS,
UNOBSTRUCTED PASSAGE WAY THAT ALLOWS
FOR APPROACH, ENTRANCE, AND EXIT TO
THE ALTERED AREA, AS WELL AS A CONNECTION
TO OTHER PARTS OF THE FACILITY. 28 CFR
36.403(E) (1) (2) (3)

PRIMARY FUNCTION: A MAJOR ACTIVITY FOR WHICH THE FACILITY IS INTENDED...OFFICES AND OTHER WORK AREAS IN WHICH THE ACTIVITIES OF THE PUBLIC

ACCOMMODATION OR PRIVATE ENTITY USING THE FACILITY ARE CARRIED OUT. 28 CFR 36.403(B)
