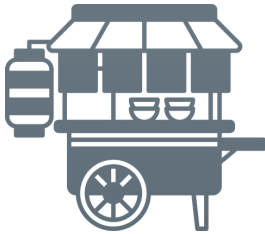

Merchant “Bubbles”

Minor sidewalk merchandise areas (merchandise “bubbles”) require a license (renewed yearly) with the City of Salina; this ensures that the policies keeping walking clear and accessible for pedestrians (especially for those with disabilities) are being adhered to. Merchants can invite buskers/other vendors to sell in their outdoor space.



Food & Beverage Pushcarts

Sidewalk vendors such as food and beverage pushcarts are permitted in the ACE District on both public and private property. Pushcart vendors must comply with City Ordinances for operation and must obtain a permit to ensure City requirements are met.

Busking & Street Performers

Street performers may engage in activities such as playing musical instruments, singing, dancing, acting, and other performance acts. A permit is not required to perform these activities **unless the performer is wanting to sell recordings, paintings, etc.** (Code Section), but is required for acoustic performances.



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Special Events

The City of Salina encourages and promotes high-quality special events and activities that advance celebrating our community’s identity, culture, and history. Pre-application meetings are not required but are highly recommended for events >500 people and/or any multi-location event.

It is necessary to reserve the location of your event. You must provide the space reservation confirmation number at the time of special event application submittal. Space reservation does not constitute confirmation of your event.
