Beginning January 1st, 2020 the City of Salina may pass on card processing fees (at actual cost) to customers as approved in the 2020 Comprehensive Fee Schedule by Resolution 19-7727.

REFUND POLICY

Program Registration:

For persons wishing to cancel their registration for any activity sponsored by our department, a full refund will be issued if staff is given at least 72 hours prior to the start of the activity. If notice is given greater than 24 hours and less than 72 hours prior to the start of the activity, a 50% cancellation fee will be withheld and the remaining amount will be refunded or credited to the user account. Notices given less than 24 hours prior to the start of the activity, or a participant's failure to show, will not be eligible for a refund. Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed and handled on a case-by-case basis.

Facility Reservations:

For persons wishing to cancel their facility reservation will need to notify the Salina Parks and Recreation office at least 2 weeks prior to the reservation to receive a full refund of the rental fee. If cancelled within 2 weeks of the event, a 50% cancellation fee will be withheld and the remaining amount of the fee will be refunded or credited to the user account. No refund will be offered due to failure to notify Salina Parks and Recreation or non-use of facility. Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed and handled on a case-by-case basis.

Trips and Tours

For trips with a registration deadline, cancellations will be accepted and a full refund will be issued prior to the registration deadline. Cancellations that occur after the registration deadline will require a replacement person in order to receive a full refund. Openings will be filled from an established waiting list.

If no replacement participant is available, persons who wish to cancel their registration after the deadline will only be eligible for a pro-rated credit to the user account. The credit amount will be equal to the actual, per person fees recovered by staff including any non-refundable deposits or ticket purchases.

For those trips with no registration deadline, cancellations will be addressed in the same way as described above. However, all refund requests will be handled on a case-by-case basis, with the amount to be determined by the timing of the request and the refund policy of each specific trip destination. Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed and handled on a case-by-case basis.

The first 24-hole golf facility in the state of Kansas features an 18-hole regulation golf course and a unique 6-hole short course. A spacious driving range, putting green, and state of the art short game area enhance the courses. With green fees consistently ranking among the lowest in the state and turf manicured to country club quality, golfers can expect a very enjoyable day!

"The Muni," is home to many group outings, leagues, tournaments and other special events. A multipurpose room is available for meetings and functions after play. Tee times can be reserved seven days a week on the 18-hole course. Playing time typically averages around 4 hours for 18-hole play during the season.

Located in Salina, Kansas – a city uniquely situated at the junction of I-135 and I-70-it features 6500 yards of rolling blue grass fairways in as fine of condition as any in the region. The large bent grass greens are normally quick and smooth and can be very deceiving with a prevailing southerly breeze. Four tee boxes on each hole give players of any ability a chance to test their skills.

Salina Trails

Located throughout the city, Salina Trails is a system of 24 miles of dedicated trails for pedestrians and bikers. Some of these trails are existing, some are planned and some are proposed for the future. Currently there are 13 miles of completed or planned trails and 11 miles of proposed trails. The trails can be divided into four different types: levee trails, multi-use, the Smoky Hill River Trail and Park nature/walking trails. Plus one mountain bike trail.
